

RESOLUTION 18-7

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF CENTRAL COUNTY WATER CONTROL DISTRICT ESTABLISHING A QUALIFYING PERIOD FOR THE OCTOBER 2018 ELECTION; DIRECTING THE DISTRICT ATTORNEY TO PUBLISH NOTICE OF THE QUALIFYING PERIOD AND ELECTION DATE; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the Central County Water Control District (the "District") is a Florida water control district operating and organized under Chapter 298, Florida Statutes, and Chapter 70-702, Laws of Florida, as amended; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors desires to establish and publish notice of a qualifying period for candidates for election for seats #1 and 5 of the District Board of Supervisors.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of the Central County Water Control District as follows:


Section 1. The Qualifying Period for candidates for election for seats #1 and 5 of the District Board of Supervisors shall open at 9 o'clock in the morning on July 16th, 2018 and shall close at ^{12 NOON} 9 o'clock in the morning on August 17th, 2018, a period of thirty days. Any qualified candidate desiring to be placed upon the official ballot of the October 2018 election must deliver written notice of their intent to run as a candidate for either seat to the District Manager with a copy to the District Attorney during the Qualifying Period. Any qualified candidate that does not provide written notice to the District Manager and a copy to the District Attorney during the Qualifying Period may still be considered as a "write-in" candidates for seats # 1 and 5.

Section 2. The District Attorney is authorized and directed to publish notice of the Qualifying Period and Election Date in the Clewiston News.

Section 3. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
