

**RESOLUTION 19-9**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF CENTRAL COUNTY WATER CONTROL DISTRICT ADOPTING A BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING ON SEPTEMBER 30, 2020; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.**

**WHEREAS**, the Central County Water Control District (the "District") is a Florida water control district operating and organized under Chapter 298, Florida Statutes, and Chapter 70-702, Laws of Florida, as amended; and

**WHEREAS**, on July 24, 2019, the District Board of Supervisors (the "Board") tentatively adopted a budget for the Fiscal Year ending on September 30, 2020; and

**WHEREAS**, on September 25, 2019, the Board considered the Final Budget for the Fiscal Year ending on September 30, 2020.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of Supervisors of the Central County Water Control District as follows:

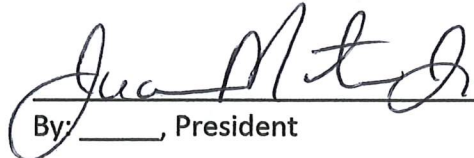

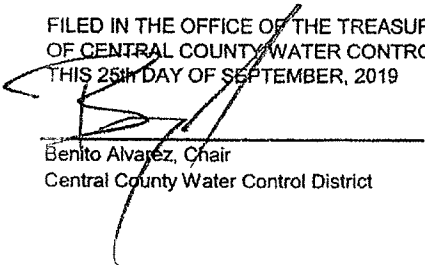
