

RESOLUTION 20-<sup>2</sup>

**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF CENTRAL COUNTY WATER CONTROL DISTRICT ESTABLISHING A QUALIFYING PERIOD FOR THE OCTOBER 2020 ELECTION; DIRECTING THE DISTRICT ATTORNEY TO PUBLISH NOTICE OF THE QUALIFYING PERIOD AND ELECTION DATE; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.**

**WHEREAS**, the Central County Water Control District (the "District") is a Florida water control district operating and organized under Chapter 298, Florida Statutes, and Chapter 70-702, Laws of Florida, as amended; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Supervisors desires to establish and publish notice of a qualifying period for candidates for election for seat #3 of the District Board of Supervisors.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of Supervisors of the Central County Water Control District as follows:

**Section 1.** The Qualifying Period for candidates for election for seat #3 of the District Board of Supervisors shall open at 9 o'clock in the morning on JULY 6<sup>th</sup>, 2020 and shall close at 9 o'clock in the morning on AUGUST 7, 2020, a period of THIRTY FIVE (35) days. Any qualified candidate desiring to be placed upon the official ballot of the October 2020 election must deliver written notice utilizing the fully completed CCWCD CANDIDATE FORM of their intent to run as a candidate for a seat #3 to the CCWCD OFFICES during the Qualifying Period. Any qualified candidate that does not provide written notice/completed CCWCD Form to the CCWCD during the Qualifying Period may still be considered a "write-in" candidate for seat #3.

**Section 2.** The District Attorney is authorized and directed to publish notice of the Qualifying Period and Election Date in the Clewiston News.


**Section 3.** This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
